




Retain the integrity of the Historic Circle as a boundary





Redistricting Process

STEP	DATE	DESCRIPTION
✓ Public Hearing #1	January 5, 2022	Present an overview of the redistricting process, hearing from community on communities of interest
✓ Public Hearing #2	February 2, 2022	Review Draft maps Take public input Consider Communities of Interest
✓ Public Hearing #3	February 16, 2022	Deadline for the public to submit draft maps for inclusion in the next hearing packet and presentation
✓ Public Hearing #4	March 16, 2022	Public Hearing to discuss and revise, if desired, the draft map(s)
Special Meeting - Map Adoption	March 23, 2022	Map adopted via ordinance Final map must be posted at least 7 days prior to adoption
Second Reading of Ordinance	April 6, 2022	Final Adoption
