- ▷ Field Will be Sanded and Fertilized in Late May, in Coordination with the American Youth Soccer Organization



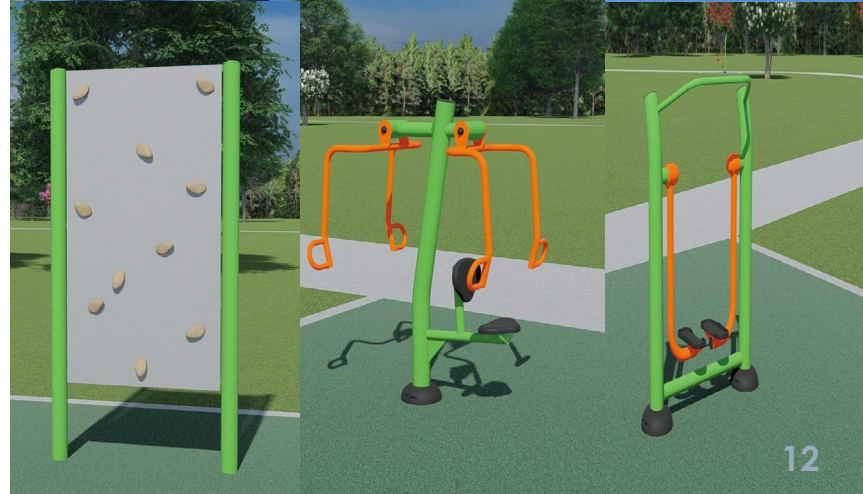


Butterfield Baseball Field
