

**CITY OF CORONA
SECOND AMENDMENT TO
MAINTENANCE/GENERAL SERVICES AGREEMENT
WITH GLOBAL POWER GROUP, INC.
(GENERATOR PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE AND “AS -NEEDED” REPAIR
SERVICES - NIB 22-001RH)**

1. PARTIES AND DATE.

This Second Amendment to the Maintenance/General Services Agreement (“Second Amendment”) is made and entered into this _____ day of _____, 2023 by and between the City of Corona (“City”) and Global Power Group, Inc., a California corporation (“Contractor”). City and Contractor are sometimes individually referred to as “Party” and collectively as “Parties” in this Second Amendment.

2. RECITALS.

2.1 Agreement. City and Contractor entered into that certain Maintenance/General Services Agreement dated October 6, 2021 (“Agreement”), whereby Contractor agreed to provide generator repair and maintenance services on an “as-needed” basis.

2.2 Prior Amendment. City and Contractor entered into that certain First Amendment to the Maintenance/General Services Agreement on or about July 25th, 2023 (“First Amendment”).

2.3 Amendment. City and Contractor desire to amend the Agreement for the second time to increase the total Compensation by \$13,000 per fiscal year through June 30, 2025.

3. TERMS.

3.1 Rates & Total Compensation. Section 3.3.1 of the Agreement, as amended by the First Amendment, is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

"Contractor shall receive compensation, including authorized reimbursements, for all Services rendered under this Agreement at the rates set forth in Exhibit "C" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. The total compensation, including authorized reimbursements, shall not exceed Two Hundred and Fifty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$255,000) per fiscal year (“Total Compensation”) without written approval of City’s Representative. Extra Work may be authorized, as described below, and if authorized, will be compensated at the rates and manner set forth in this Agreement."

3.2 Continuing Effect of Agreement. Except as amended by this Second Amendment, all provisions of the Agreement shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

From and after the date of this Second Amendment, whenever the term “Agreement” appears in the Agreement, it shall mean the Agreement as amended by this Second Amendment.

3.3 Adequate Consideration. The Parties hereto irrevocably stipulate and agree that they have each received adequate and independent consideration for the performance of the obligations they have undertaken pursuant to this Second Amendment.

3.4 Counterparts. This Second Amendment may be executed in duplicate originals, each of which is deemed to be an original, but when taken together shall constitute but one and the same instrument.



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


