The Ask

That the City Council approve a resolution affirming its desire to preserve the Skyline Area Property in its natural state.

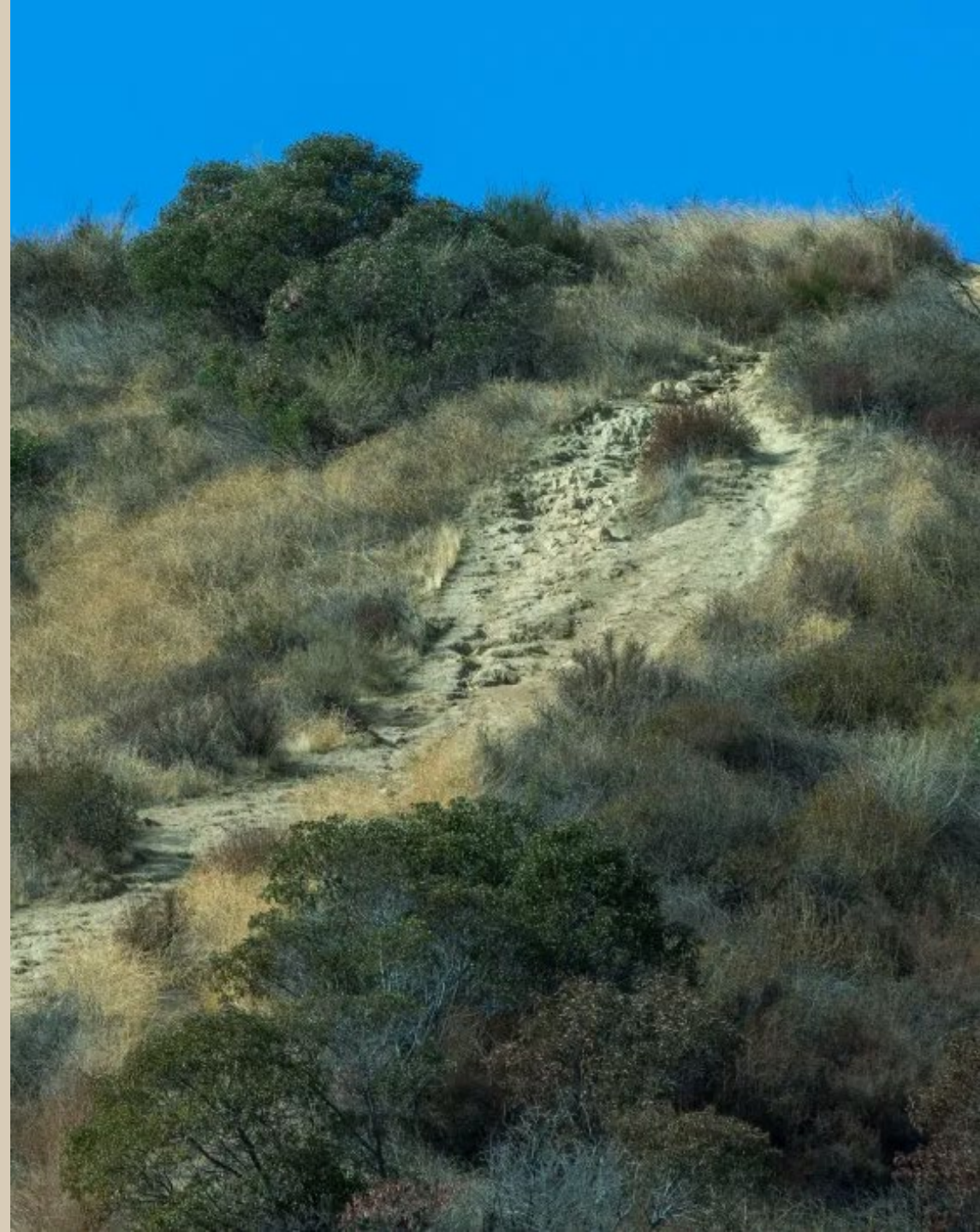


Skyline

- In 2020, the City Council purchased 292 acres of the Skyline area to preserve it in its natural state
- In January 2024, Vice Mayor Steiner asked staff to draft a resolution to affirm the City and Council's desire to preserve the Skyline Trail Area property, recognizing its value as a natural habitat and recreational asset for the community.
- This resolution affirms the City's intent to maintain and preserve this area in its natural state.

Skyline Resolution

- Affirmation of Commitment to preserving the 292 acres of the Skyline area
- Reiterates that only minor amenities shall be permitted within the preserved area.
- Prioritize environmental stewardship in activities related to the Skyline area
- Prohibits the construction of parking facilities within the boundaries of the 62.36-acre meadow area
- Ensure that the natural beauty and ecological integrity of the Skyline area are preserved
