COMMUNICATIONS FROM THE PUBLIC

The following residents addressed the Council to request additional pickle ball courts in the City: Ryo Shinalawa, Mike Wagoner, Jerry Miguel, and Larry Baril.

AGENDA ITEMS

1. CITY PARK MASTER PLAN REVIEW

Moses Cortez, Facilities, Parks and Trails Manager, introduced the item and Mr. Mueting, Consultant with RJM. who provided a presentation highlighting the following: Project Purpose, Community Voice, History, Site Analysis, Program Workshop - Bubble Diagram, Massing Plan, Trails Opportunities Plan, Aquatics, Splash Pad & Playground, Multi-Use Field, Community Buildings, All Wheel Plaza, Parking, Case Study - Fullerton, Case Study - Mission Viejo, and Conceptual Renderings. Donna Finch, Interim Community Services Director, provided a brief overview of the Roadmap for the City Park Masterplan and the goal to have the opening in Spring/Summer 2027.

Ryo Shinagawa, resident, addressed the Council regarding additional pickle ball courts at the City Park.

The Council discussed the item and had inquiries. Mr. Cortez, Mr. Mueting, and Jacob Ellis, City Manager, provided clarification.

Justin Tucker, Assistant City Manager, requested clarification for direction size of skate park and possibility of adding pickle ball courts. The Council agreed to keep the plans as the community requested and Mr. Ellis addressed that expanding pickle ball within the City will be coming in the future.
