YEAR-END REVIEW 2022

By the Numbers

- Mosquito Samples Tested: 43/0 positive for mosquito-borne diseases
- Inspections: 6629
- Treatments: 1090
- Service Request: 562
 - 279 mosquitoes(49.6%), 116 rodents (20.6%), 167 other (29.8%)
- Top 5 Mosquito Species Collected(District wide):
 - I. Culex erythrothorax: 50.81%
 - 2. Culex tarsalis: 19.92%
 - 3. Culex quinquefasciatus: 18.7%
 - 4. Anopheles hermsi: 3.95%
 - 5. Aedes aegypti: 3.43%
- Northwest MVCD attended many public outreach events throughout the city including the Corona Night Market.





Toss

If possible, scrub and throw away all containers that can hold water for more than 2-3 days.

Remove standing water from containers found around your house.
