AGENDA ITEMS

1. 6TH STREET TRANSFORMATION DESIGN CONCEPTS

Keegan Olds, CIP Supervisor, introduced the item and Jitka Dekojova, Studio OneEleven, provided a presentation highlighting the following: 6th Street Transformation Design Concepts, Project Area Context, Project Area Connectivity, Project Area Priorities from Past Planning Efforts from Downtown Revitalization Plan, Project Area Downtown Design Guidelines, Project Goals and Priorities for 6th Street Transformation, Project Area Pre-Stripping Conditions, West Block, East Block, 6th Street Transformation Conceptual Design Options Overview, Design Precedents Option A, Section Plan Option B, Section and Plan Option C, Key Features Breakdown, and Comparison of Options Against Goals and Priorities.

The following addressed the Council to express their concerns with the proposed item: Joe Morgan, Maddy Paxton, and Jeff Johnson.

The council had inquiries, Mr. Olds, Aaron Cox, Senior Engineer Traffic, Savat Khamphou, Public Works Director, provided clarification. The Council provided comments. The consensus was to bring Option A and Option B to a future City Council meeting.

2. TEN-YEAR PAVEMENT MANAGEMENT PLAN

Keegan Olds, CIP Supervisor, introduced the item and provided a presentation highlighting the following: Ten-Year Pavement Management Plan, Pavement Management Plan, PMP Components Traffic Circulation Element, Roadway Classifications, Pavement Condition Measure, Types of Pavement Distresses, Pavement Life Cycle, Category I, Category II, Category III, Category IV, Category III & IV, Category V, Pavement Deterioration Curve, Background, Public Works Roles, Previous Efforts, Existing Funding Sources, Proposed 10 Year Plan, Proposed Plan Zone Distribution, Pavement Management Plan Options, Option 1 Fair Condition, Option 2 Good Condition, Option 3 Good+ Condition, Projected PCI in 20 Years, and Pros and Cons.

The Council had inquiries, Mr. Olds and Public Works employees provided clarification.
