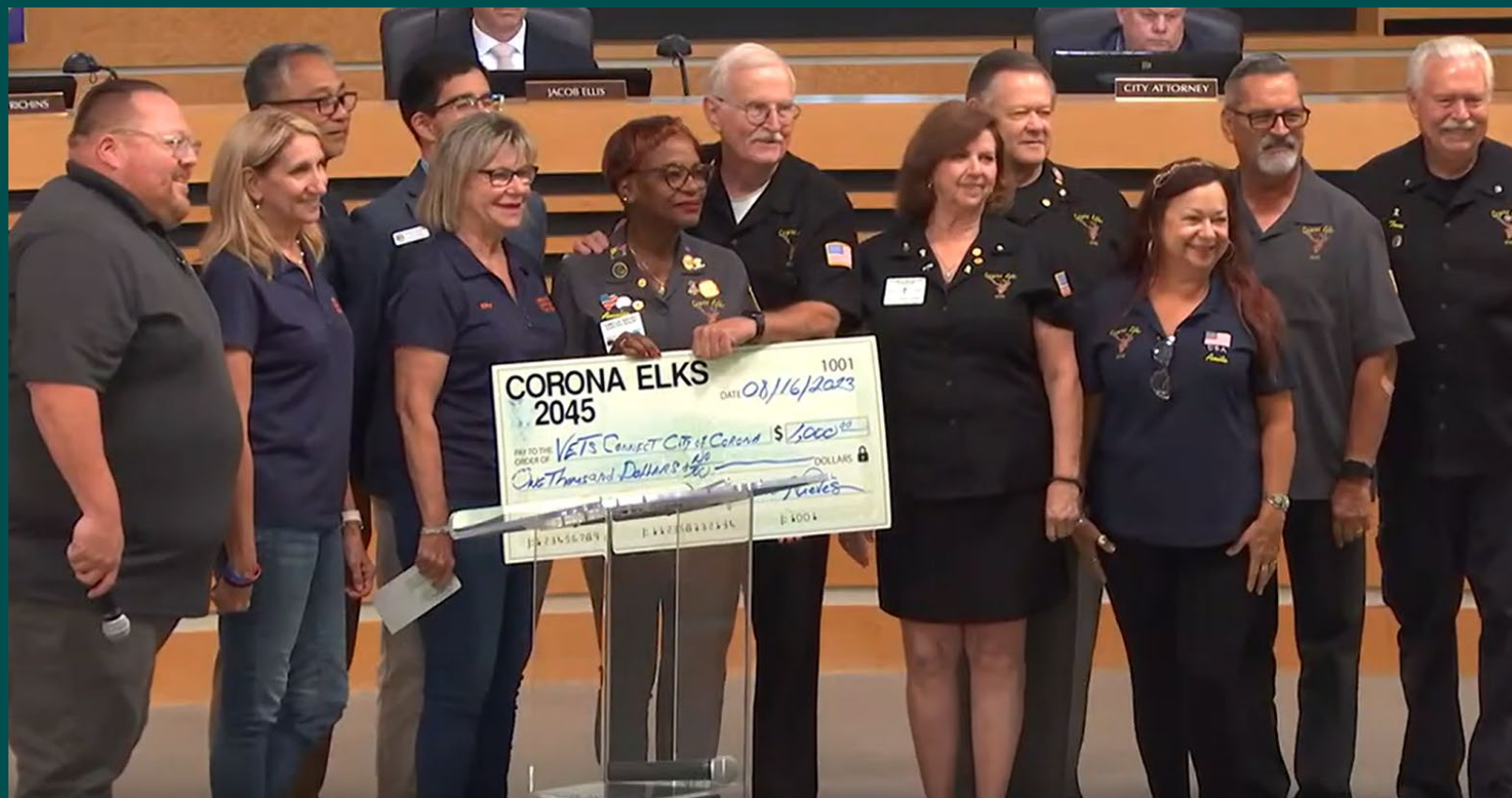
Program Overview
