- A high number of swimming pools have been inspected/treated in the City of Corona
- This is typically done in the spring and pools with mosquito larvae are treated with residual products
- Residents receiving a notice can text a photo of their clean pool to the District's **POOL** line at 951-870-0607

Swimming pools are a common breeding site for mosquitoes in neighborhoods. Northwest MVCD needs to confirm that your pool is in good working order and not breeding mosquitoes.

3 ways to confirm:

1. Text a photo to **951-870-0607** or
2. Email a photo to **office@northwestmvcd.org**

This notice **MUST** be in the **SAME** photo as the pool.

3. Schedule an inspection: Call **951-340-9792**

A vector control technician can come out and do an inspection and if needed help control mosquitoes at no cost until pool is in good working condition.
