# Artist Eligibility

- ▷ Open to Corona artists 16 years and older
- ▷ Timeline of the phases of installation must be included
- ▷ Outline of the incorporation of City's volunteers
- ▷ Artist with considered artwork will be notified

# Artwork Guidelines

## DO:

- ✓ Family-friendly artwork
- ✓ Bright colors
- ✓ Incorporate Corona's heritage, parks, events, landmarks
- ✓ Build community, highlight Corona's cultural diversity
- ✓ Images of nature, inspiration, and beauty
- ✓ Be original, innovative, have fun!

## DON'T:

- ✗ Profanity or violent images
- ✗ Advertise business, political views, or religion
- ✗ Copyrighted or trademarked imagery

- ▷ 40 x 8 (short side) x 2

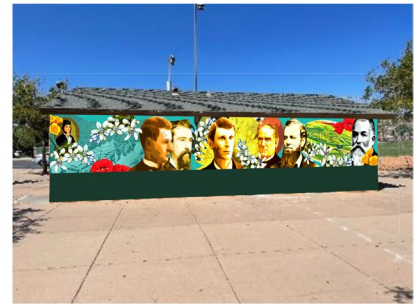

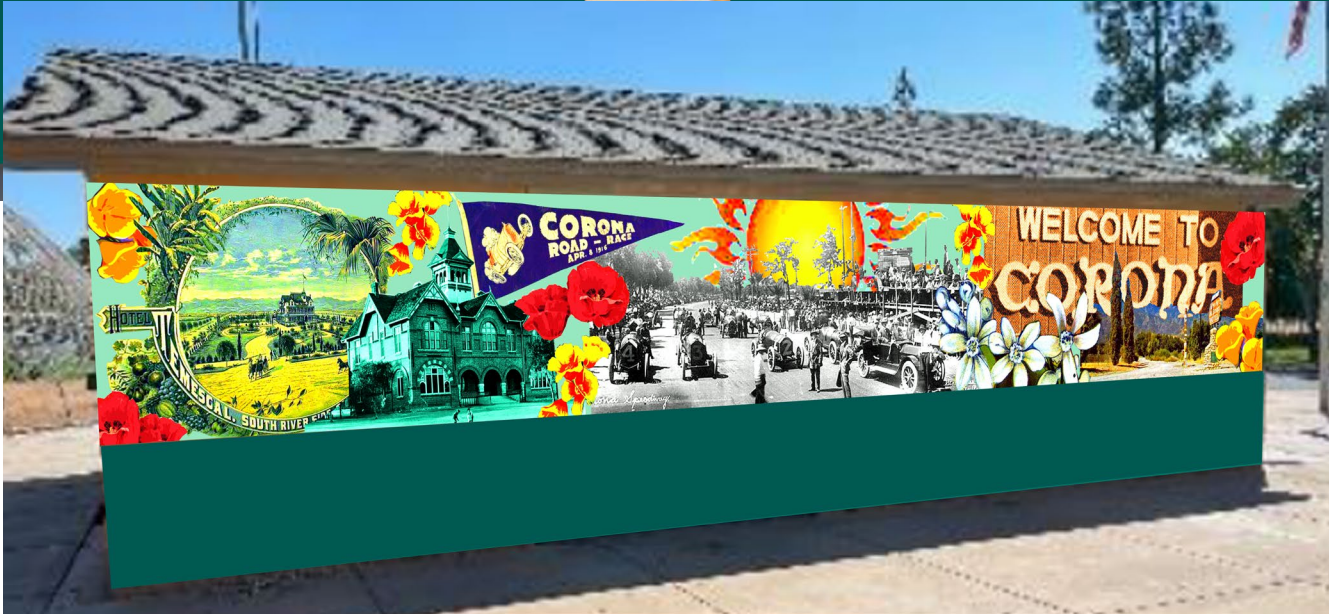

Back Wall / Concessions side- Tennis, Hiking, Pavilion parties, Lemon Groves and playground



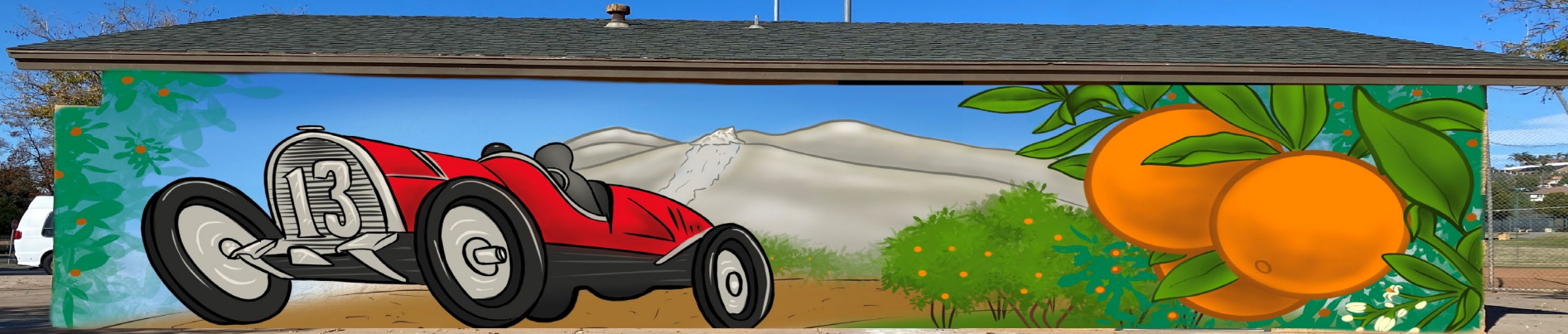
