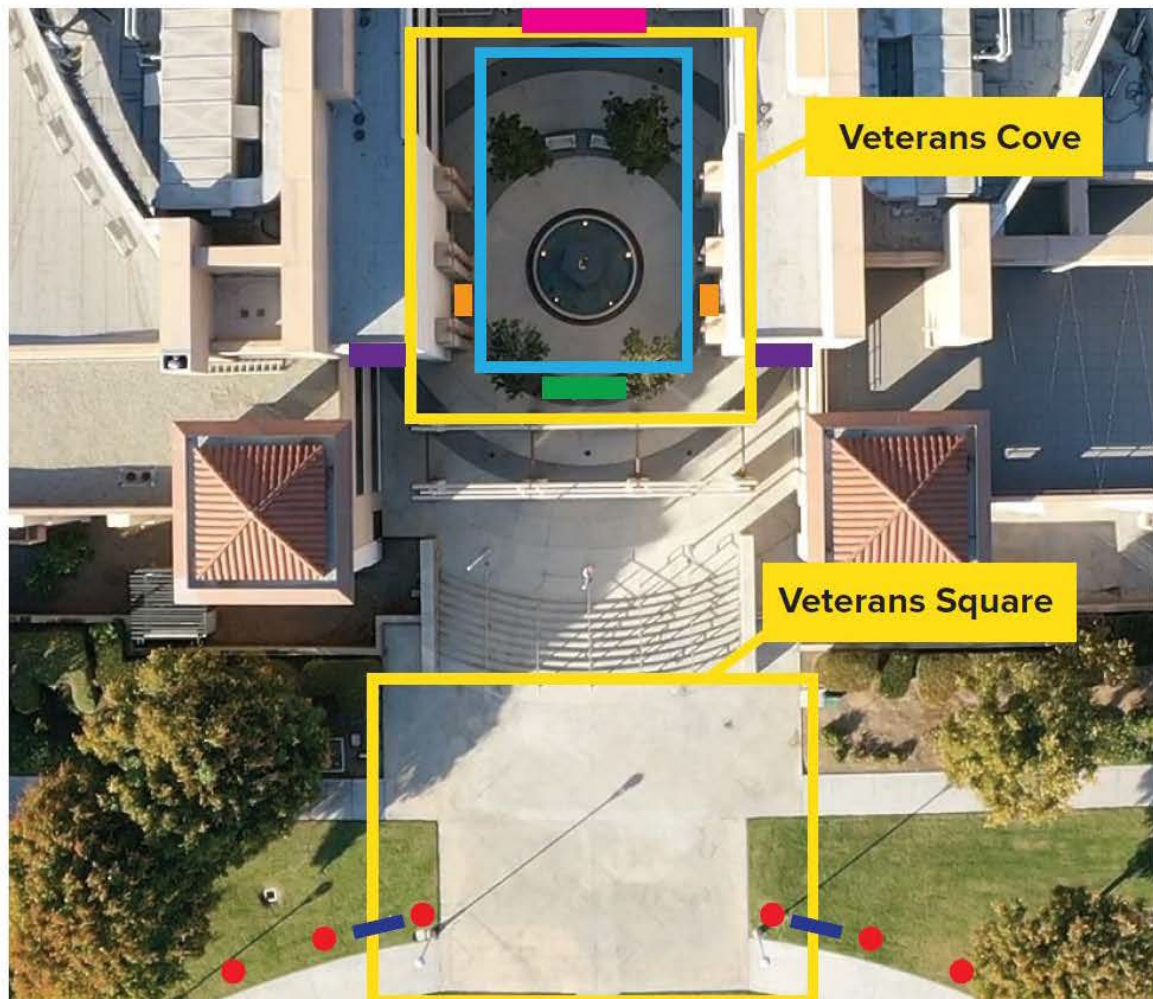

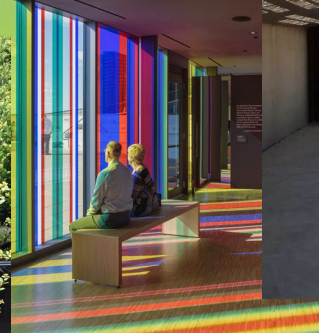


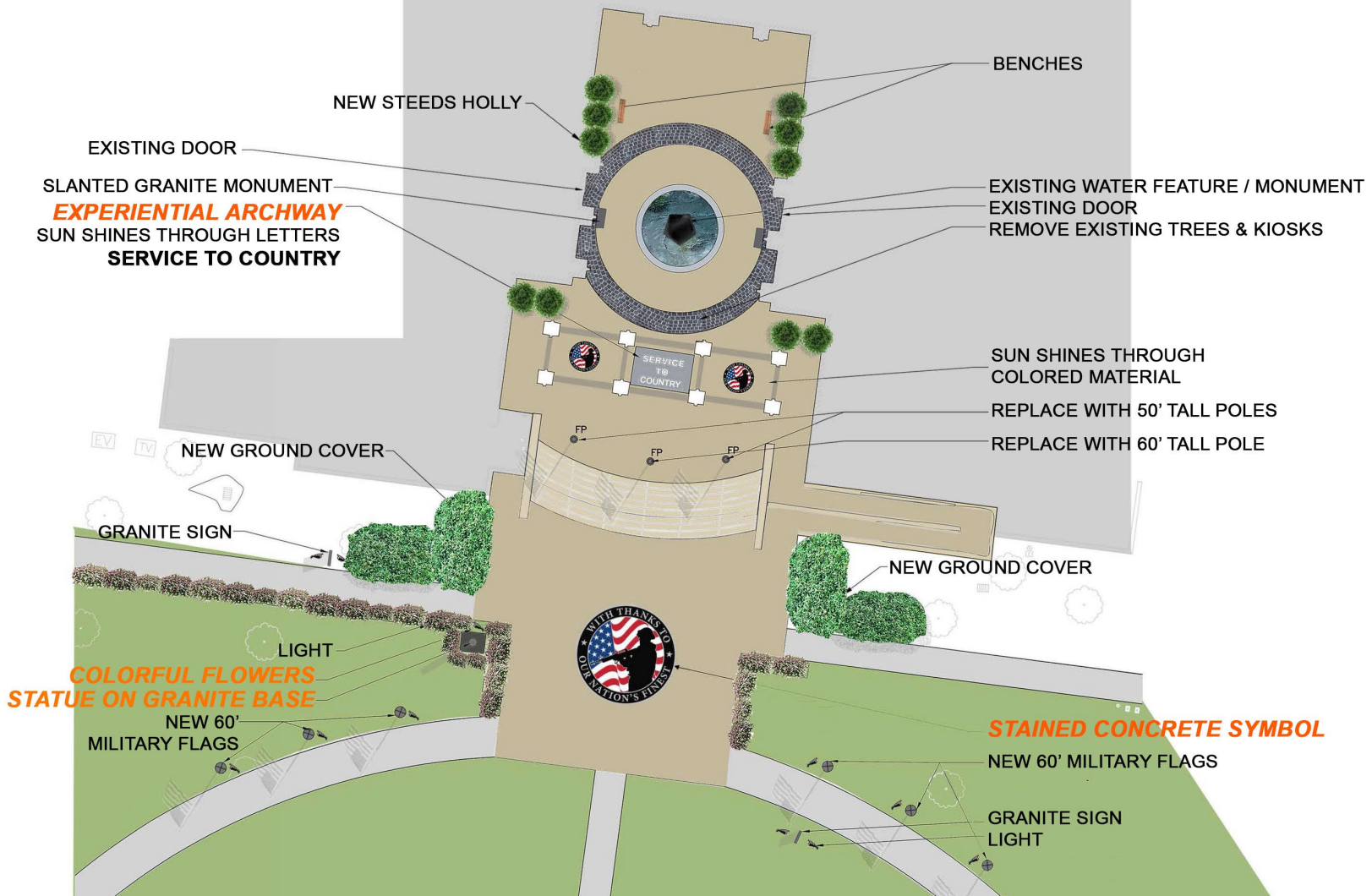
Patriotism

**CONCEPT 1:
SERVICE TO COUNTRY**

Main Features:

- ▷ Patriotic red, white and blue flower beds
- ▷ Bronze statue
- ▷ Concrete stained banner in Veteran's Square
- ▷ Flag promenade along walkway
- ▷ Granite signs
- ▷ **Experiential archway**
- ▷ Slanted granite monuments



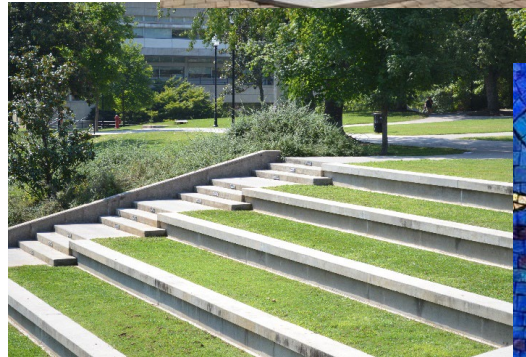


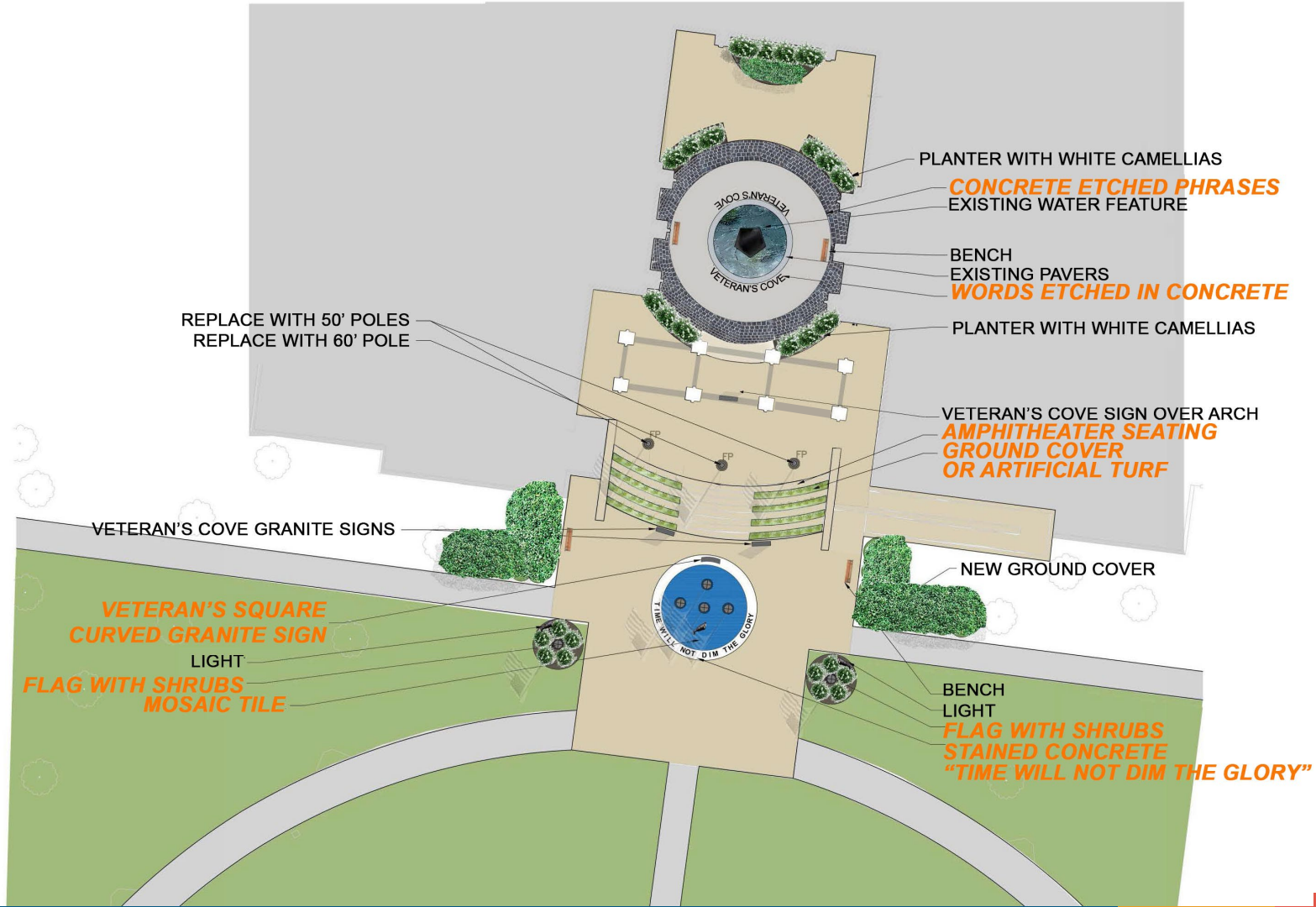
Calm & Reflect

**CONCEPT 2:
HONOR AND GLORY**

Main Features:

- ▷ Expanded planting areas
- ▷ **Amphitheater seating**
- ▷ **Unique flag arrangement**
- ▷ Tall granite walls
- ▷ Camellias and ground cover
- ▷ Stained/etched concrete
- ▷ **Mosaic tile**

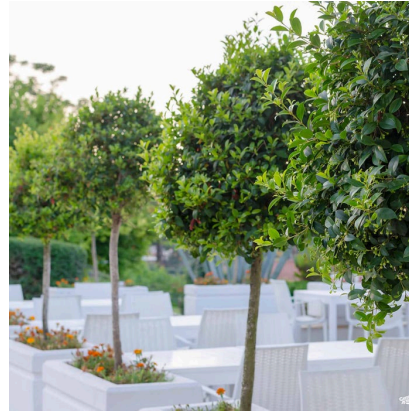

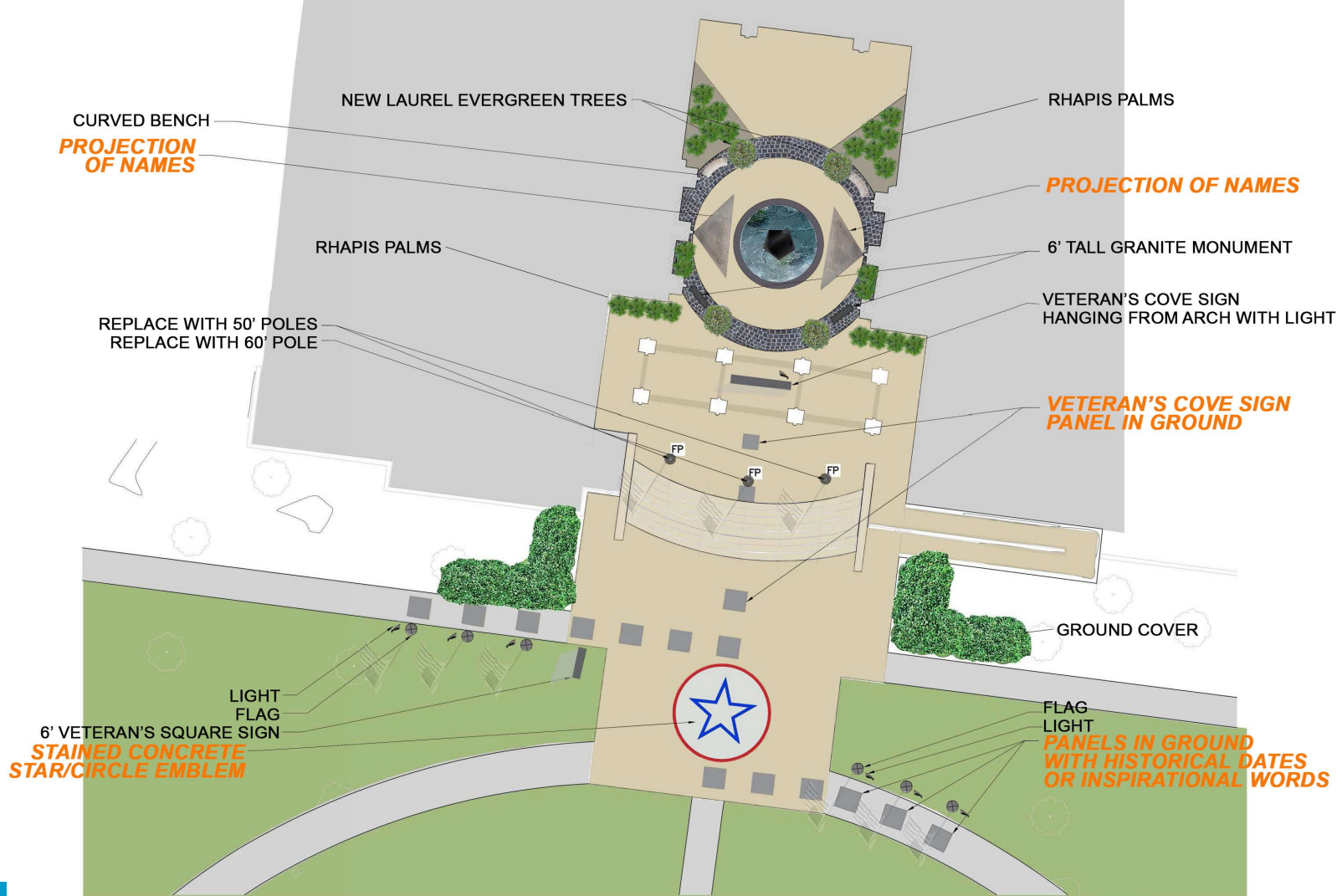

**CONCEPT 3:
SOLITUDE & REMEMBRANCE**

Main Features:

- ▷ **Pathway panels in concrete**
- ▷ 6' tall granite monuments
- ▷ **Nighttime projection of names**
- ▷ Curved bench seating
- ▷ Laurel Evergreen trees and Rhapsis palms
- ▷ **Stained concrete star/circle emblem**





Project Costs
