Mr. Jacob Ellis, City Manager, provided the Committee with an update on the City's Military Banner program. Mr. Ellis presented new locations to expand the military banner program to eliminate long applicant wait time. Due to the program's overwhelming success, applicants are placed on a wait list until light poles become available. With the expansion of the military banner zones, more light poles become available for use. Proposed locations - McKinley St. - from 91 FWY to Promenade Ave., Magnolia Ave. - S. Main St. to Ontario Ave., Ontario Ave. - starting from Main St. with the ability to expand as needed to reduce/eliminate wait lists. Mr. Ellis noted that all banner locations are selected at random.

The Committee was in favor of proposed locations and thanked staff for updates.
