Background and Budget




Staff

- Eleven members 9 staff, 1 lead, 1 supervisor (time split between Parks and LMDs)
- Budget \$105,000 for overtime annually within Parks division
- 2,080 hours/person/year x 9 people = 18,720 hours
- Regular assignments, training, time off, one-time assignments and annual evaluations of facilities and needs

Budget

- 110 General Fund budget of \$4,292,496 (staff and services)
- Budgeting and tracking PO's and RPO's
- CIPs
- Zero-Based Budgeting
 - Tasks are defined and task are assigned an object code
 - Unit of measure x cost per unit x frequency = annual budget
- Budget for LMDs/CFDs varies by zone, 17 total




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Landscaping


Weekly and Monthly Contractor Services Provided:

- Weekly mowing
- Weekly edging and weed whipping
- Weed control (manual and spraying)
- Vine trimming
- Shrub and bush trimming
- Ground cover edge/trim
- Irrigation testing, maintenance and repair
- Playground chips leveled



Quarterly and Annual Tasks:

- Bi-Weekly Mowing (Nov-Feb)
- Heavy Trimming and clean up
- Tree Canopies lifted to 15' clearance
- Backflow and cages painted
- Curb markings painted
- Approved irrigation upgrades & indepth irrigation repairs

Weekly Field Mowing: In House (45 Acres of Mowing)

- Butterfield Park (9 BB/softball fields = 12.27)
- Eagle Glen (2 soccer fields = 3.44)
- Santana Park (5 soccer fields = 8.11)
- Citrus Park (2 all-purpose fields = 3.61)
- Mtn Gate Park (3 BB fields = 5.55)
- Promenade Park (2 BB fields = 2.64)
- El Cerrito Park (3 soccer/ 4 BB fields = 9.06)

(Fields are cut a minimum of once per week; schedules are adjusted based on tournaments and sometimes cut twice based on the tournament needs)



Field Renovations (Winter and Summer)

- ► Fields Over seeded
- Irrigation checked and adjusted
- ► Turf fields fertilized
- ► Turf aerated
- Turf and infields leveled
- Ball fields clay added and leveled
- Mounds and batter boxes filled in
- Ball field pegs checked and plates replaced as needed
- Back stops repaired
- ► Sports lights serviced



Cal Sense Central Irrigation Controllers:

- 4 Hubs
- 450+ controllers
- Evapotranspiration gauges communicate back to hubs
- Pulling weekly alerts and irrigation reports for contractor to perform repairs



Janitorial

Janitorial and Restroom Services:

- Contractor has 3 separate crews, contractor services parks between 6:00am-12:30pm
- Daily services include: stocking paper goods, mopping and cleaning all fixtures and toilets, and trash removal
- Weekly items include: Washing of floors and building
- Monthly items: high dusting, cob web and cleaning of light fixtures



Janitorial Schedule:

Crew 1

Mon, Tues, Wed, Thur, Fri, Sat, Sun - City Park Pool, Promenade, Rock Vista, Parkview, Tehachapi, Butterfield, Lincoln, Ontario, Fairview and El Cerrito *Husted (only cleaned Mondays and Fridays)

Crew 2

Mon, Wed, Fri, Sat, Sun - Stagecoach, Brentwood, Mangular, Border, Serfas Club and Ridgeline

Crew 3

Mon, Tues, Wed, Thur, Fri, Sat, Sun - Santana, Rimpau, Kellogg, Citrus, Chase, Eagle Glen, Spyglass, Jameson, Mtn Gate and Buena Vista

Trash Services:

- In-house staff services (three times a week): 185 cans throughout our neighborhood parks
- Contractual services (daily, including holidays): 310 cans located at sports parks (listed below)

 - Promenade Park
 - Citrus Park






- Painting
- Playground repairs
- Repairs to doors, benches, fountains, restrooms, etc.



Power Washing:

Reservation locations and sports parks picnic shelters are power washed weekly.



Pool and Splash Pad Maintenance:

- Citrus Splash Pad
- Ridgeline Splash Pad
- Auburndale Pool
- City Park Pool*
- Checked six times a week by staff or contractor
- Chemicals, Water Quality Testing & Repairs performed by Commercial Aquatic

*City Park Pool is checked daily; vacuumed and brushed weekly





Graffiti Services:

Number of Service Requests for Fiscal Year 18-19: 1,388 service request

Monthly City Park Clean Ups:





- ► Trash and debris removal
- Power washing and disinfecting

- Approximately 56-64 staff hours per clean up event (7-8 staff for 8 hours on average)

300,000 square feet cut each year (on average)


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DWP Sites Landscaping:

► 69 sites serviced by Tropical Plaza and on-call contractor (LR Landscaping)

Monthly and weekly services include: mowing, trimming, weeding, litter and trash pickup and weed abatement

Staff inspects sites and will set irrigation controllers; works with contractor on repairs or punch list items



Airport Maintenance:

- Mowing and maintenance of Grounds and Runway Protection Zone (RPZ) (monthly)
- Trash service (weekly)
- Trees trimmed for clearance (starting October)
- RPZ brush removal (October-November)
- Staff provides all support supplies for Cal Fire crews including, but not limited, to: Portable toilets, weed trimmers, fuel, trimmer line, bar oil, additional hand tools and trash bins



Fire Station Landscape Maintenance:

- Station 1: Oak West
- Station 2: Oak West
- Station 3: Oak West
- Station 4: Oak West
- Station 5: Tropical Plaza
- Station 6: DMS Services
- Station 7: DMS Services




Special Events:

- Volunteer groups: Churches, Boy Scouts, local businesses
- Co-sponsored events: 10 in FY 18-19
- City events: 4th of July, Holiday Lighting
- League opening days: Spring and Winter seasons
- League tournaments throughout year: 7 weekend or week-long tournaments
- 542 picnic shelter reservations in FY 18-19



Safety training and Continuing Education Units:

- Staff spends time keeping up on their classes and training
- Staff has approximately 35 class that work on keeping current to ensure safety for all staff (approximately 15-20 hours per year)
- Staff attend training seminars for Arborist (ISA) and for pesticide (PAPA) as well as certified irrigators (IA) (approximately 16-24 hours per year)
