

ADULT LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES



The Corona Public Library's Adult Reading Assistance Program has partnered with the Corona-Norco Adult School to offer free classes this Fall, including English as a Second Language (ESL), Basic Computer Skills, and Citizenship Preparation in a virtual setting.

COURSE NAME DESCRIPTION

English as a Second Language*

Provides learners with life, literacy, and language skills. ESL learners engage in civic, integrated training, and workforce preparation activities alongside reading, writing, listening, and speaking skills.

Basic Computer Skills & Online Literacy*

This 8-week course introduces fundamental computer and online knowledge and skills. Learn about email basics, google tools, online privacy, and more. This class will help students gain confidence in their digital capabilities.

Citizenship Preparation*

We work to prepare students to pass the Citizenship interview in English! We will help students fill out a practice N-400 application and practice reading, writing, speaking, listening to, and understanding English.

*Class sessions may be cancelled if sufficient enrollment is not met.
