Mosquitoes

- 4 mosquito samples have tested positive for West Nile virus within district boundaries in 2022
 - 3 in Riverside, 1 in Eastvale

Ticks

- Brown dog ticks are becoming more active due to the warmer temperatures
- Brown dog ticks are <u>not</u> a vector of Lyme disease, but can infest indoor and outdoor spaces
- Regular inspections of animals is key in identifying infestations
- If ticks are found on animals, they should be removed with tweezers as close to the skin as possible, consult your veterinarian
 - Do NOT grab body of the tick as it may "squeeze" body fluids from the tick into the skin opening
