**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
CORONA, CALIFORNIA TERMINATING AS OF  
OCTOBER 25, 2017, THE PROCLAMATION OF A LOCAL  
EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, on September 25, 2017, conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property arose within the City of Corona, California; and

**WHEREAS**, the Emergency Services Director proclaimed a local emergency due to the wind-driven wildfire known as the Canyon Fire that started at approximately 1:00 p.m.; and

**WHEREAS**, properties, both public and private, experienced damage as a result of the fire and secondary hazards; and

**WHEREAS**, the Corona City Council ratified said action on September 28, 2017 by the adoption of Resolution No. 2017-104; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with California Government Code Section 8630, the governing body shall proclaim the termination of the local emergency at the earliest possible date that conditions warrant.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND DECLARED** by the City Council of the City of Corona, California, the Proclaimed Local Emergency is hereby terminated.
