

**RESOLUTION NO. 2017-119**

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
CORONA, CALIFORNIA, DECLARING THE CITY'S  
SUPPORT OF THE 2020 UNITED STATES CENSUS**

**WHEREAS**, the United States (U.S.) Census Bureau is required by the Constitution of the United States of America to conduct a count of the population which provides a historic opportunity to help shape the foundation of our society and play an active role in American democracy; and

**WHEREAS**, the U.S. Census is committed to ensuring every resident is counted;  
and

**WHEREAS**, more than \$300 billion per year in federal and state funding is allocated to communities, and decisions are made on matters of national and local importance based on census data, including healthcare, community development, housing, education, transportation, social services, employment, and much more; and

**WHEREAS**, census data determine how many seats each state will have in the U.S. House of Representatives as well as redistricting of state legislatures, county and city councils, and voting districts; and

**WHEREAS**, the 2020 Census creates hundreds of thousands of jobs across the nation; and

**WHEREAS**, every Census Bureau worker takes a lifetime oath to protect the confidentiality and ensure that data identifying respondents of their household not be released or shared for 72 years; and

**WHEREAS**, a united voice from businesses, government, community-based and faith-based organizations, educators, media and others will allow the 2020 Census message to reach a broader audience, providing trusted advocates who can spark positive conversations about the 2020 Census.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Corona, California, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The City Council supports the goals and ideals for the 2020 Census and encourages community participation.

**SECTION 2.** The City Council appeals to local organizations and groups to partner together in achieving an accurate and complete count within the City.

**SECTION 3.** The City Council encourages residents to participate in 2020 Census promotional events.
