AMENDMENT NO. 4 TO THE

AMENDED AND RESTATED EXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF CORONA AND USA WASTE OF CALIFORNIA, INC. FOR SOLID WASTE HANDLING SERVICES

This AMENDMENT NO. 4 TO THE AMENDED AND RESTATED EXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF CORONA AND USA WASTE OF CALIFORNIA, INC. FOR SOLID WASTE HANDLING SERVICES ("Amendment") is dated as of June 21, 2017, and is entered into by and between USA WASTE OF CALIFORNIA, INC., a Delaware corporation ("Contractor") and the CITY OF CORONA, a municipal corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of California ("City"). Contractor and City are sometimes referred to in this Agreement, individually as "Party" and, collectively as "Parties."

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Contractor and the City entered into an "Amended and Restated Exclusive Franchise Agreement Between the City of Corona and USA Waste of California, Inc. for Solid Waste Handling Services" ("Original Agreement") dated July 5, 2006, wherein the Parties contracted for Contractor to provide exclusive solid waste handling services to the City; and

WHEREAS, Contractor and the City entered into an "Amendment No. 1 to the Amended and Restated Exclusive Franchise Agreement Between the City of Corona and USA Waste of California, Inc. for Solid Waste Handling Services" ("Amendment No. 1") dated June 20, 2007, to modify the procedures for adjusting Contractor's rates for solid waste handling services; and

WHEREAS, Contractor and the City entered into an "Amendment No. 2 to the Amended and Restated Exclusive Franchise Agreement Between the City of Corona and USA Waste of California, Inc. for Solid Waste Handling Services" ("Amendment No. 2") dated June 5, 2009, to delegate authority to Contractor to issue notices for the removal of third-party waste collection containers and to impound such containers under certain conditions pursuant to Corona Municipal Code Section 8.20.085; and

WHEREAS, Contractor and the City entered into an "Amendment No. 3 to the Amended and Restated Exclusive Franchise Agreement Between the City of Corona and USA Waste of California, Inc. for Solid Waste Handling Services" ("Amendment No. 3") dated May 17, 2017, to increase the franchise fee from eleven percent (11%) to fifteen percent (15%) for commercial and roll-off services; and

WHEREAS, the Original Agreement, Amendment No. 1, Amendment No. 2 and Amendment No. 3 shall be collectively referred to as the "Agreement" in this Amendment; and

WHEREAS, Section 18B of the Agreement states that the approved rates shall be reviewed annually and may be adjusted to reflect changes in the Consumer Price Index ("CPI") based on the CPI index for all urban consumers within the Los Angeles-Anaheim-Riverside Metropolitan Area during the March to March period; and

WHEREAS, Waste Management desires to change the CPI index to be used to adjust the rates to the United States Bureau of Labor Statistics ("US BLS") CPI for Water, Sewer & Trash because it is more indicative of increases for the services they provide; and

WHEREAS, Waste Management also desires to adjust the time period for calculating the change in the CPI to December to December to ensure that they can provide proper notification to the City and Waste Management customers; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2017-051, the City Council established certain rates for additional solid waste services, including a Residential Billing Charge and a Recycling Administrative Service Charge; and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to update Exhibit "C" of the Agreement to incorporate the updated rates approved by Resolution No. 2017-051.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties hereto agree as follows:

1. Section 18B of the Agreement is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

"B. MODIFICATION AND ADJUSTMENT OF RATES

Rates set forth in Exhibit C shall remain in effect until adjusted by action of the City Council.

Annual Rate Adjustment. Approved rates shall be reviewed annually and may be adjusted to reflect changes in the Consumer Price Index (CPI). Grantee shall submit adjustment requests to the City by May 1 of each calendar year. The adjustments shall reflect the change in the CPI index for the United States Department Bureau of Labor Statistics CPI for Water, Sewer & Trash during the December to December period just passed. A grant of a rate adjustment shall be by ordinance or by resolution following a public hearing concerning the proposed increase. City Council shall not unreasonably deny a requested rate increase. If granted, the adjustments shall be effective on July 1 of each calendar year, unless otherwise specified in the ordinance or resolution adopted by the City Council. This adjustment shall apply to the collection

component of the current rate, which is the total rate less landfilling cost.

Landfilling Cost Adjustment. The landfilling fee portion of the rate schedule shall be adjusted only when landfilling costs increase or decrease and may be applied on a prorated basis to customers. Such adjustments in the landfilling fee portion of the rate schedule ("Landfill Fee Adjustments") may be approved by the City Manager or his or her designee, which approval shall not be unreasonably withheld, provided however that 1) the Landfill Fee Adjustment approval process is not applicable to cost adjustments imposed by landfill facilities at which the rates or fees are established or controlled by Grantee or any of its Affiliated Companies; 2) Grantee provides notice to customers of any such Landfill Fee Adjustment per Section 18.C below; and 3) Grantee provides City with a calculation of how such Landfill Fee Adjustment is derived. To the extent that Grantee disposes of, processes, or recycles materials at a facility that it owns, operates, or controls (or that is owned, operated, or controlled by any Affiliated Company) ("Grantee-controlled Landfill Facility"), the landfill costs charged to City customers shall be equal to or less than the lowest landfill rates charged to any other city in western Riverside County to which the Grantee provides services similar to those provided to the City. To the extent that Grantee disposes of, processes, or recycles materials at a landfill facility for which the rates or fees are established or controlled by Grantee or any of its Affiliated Companies, such landfill costs shall be processed in the same manner as the service component changes and shall also be effective on July 1 annually, unless otherwise specified by the City Manager or in the ordinance or resolution adopted by the City Council.

It is the intent of the City that the CPI-based rate adjustments allowed by this Section 18 continue the CPI-based formula for service rate increases and landfill cost-based formula for landfill rate increases adopted by the City on April 1, 1992 as part of the prior franchise agreement. It is also the intent of the City that the rate increase mechanisms described in this Section be a "clearly defined formula for inflation adjustment" for purposes of California Government Code Section 53750."

2. Exhibit C (Schedule of Rates) of the Agreement is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with Exhibit C-4 (Schedule of Rates) attached hereto, which shall become effective as of August 1, 2017.

- 3. This Amendment shall supersede any term or provision of the Agreement to the contrary, and in the event of a conflict between this Amendment and the Agreement, this Amendment shall control.
- 4. All other provisions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect and shall apply as applicable to this Amendment. This Amendment shall not be given retroactive effect.
