

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-018

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORONA, CALIFORNIA, ESTABLISHING A WAIVER FOR THE PLAN CHECK AND PERMIT FEES FOR THE RENOVATION OF THE KITCHEN AT JOE DOMINGUEZ AMERICAN LEGION POST 742 LOCATED AT 1557 YORBA STREET, CORONA.

WHEREAS, Chapter 3.02 of the Corona Municipal Code (“Code”) establishes fees to recover the percentage of costs reasonably borne in providing certain services to the community; and

WHEREAS, Section 3.02.040 of the Code, lists percentage of costs reasonably borne to be recovered, by building and construction activities in the City of Corona; and

WHEREAS, the Joe Dominguez American Legion Post 742 is located at 1557 Yorba Street, Corona, CA and is 70 years old; and

WHEREAS, the Joe Dominguez American Legion Post 742 is a 501(c)(19) non-profit organization that provides various services to veterans and has limited funds to renovate the existing kitchen in the building; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Leadership Roundtable Class of 2017-18 sponsored by the Corona Chamber of Commerce is actively raising funds to renovate the existing kitchen as a community service project for the veterans that are members of the Joe Dominguez American Legion Post 742; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to waive the plan check and permit fees (“Waiver”) for the kitchen renovation for Joe Dominguez American Legion Post 742 located at 1557 Yorba Street, Corona, California (“Property”); and

WHEREAS, the City Council hereby finds that it is in the public interest and general welfare to establish the Waiver, which will benefit the City and the greater community; and

WHEREAS, the City Council hereby finds that the written and other evidence submitted by City Staff substantiates the contention that the fee should be waived; and

WHEREAS, waiver of fees as provided in this Resolution serves a public purpose and provides a public benefit to the local community as a whole as the funds being raised by the Executive Leadership Roundtable Class of 2017-18 are being done by a fundraiser

to improve the condition of a 70 year old kitchen for the members of the Joe Dominguez American Legion Post 742.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Corona, California, as follows:

SECTION 1. The recitals stated above are true and correct, and are hereby incorporated as findings made by the City Council.

SECTION 2. The fee imposed by Chapter 3.02 of the Corona Municipal Code for the plan check and permit fees shall be waived for the kitchen renovation at Joe Dominguez American Legion Post 742 located at 1557 Yorba Street, Corona.

SECTION 3. Severability. If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase adopted by this Resolution, or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this Resolution or any part thereof. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases are declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
