Parks and MS service staff working on rain events to keep drains, v- ditches and the public right-of-way clear and safe






# Historic Lemon Tree Graft (Joy Park) Update:

# Winter Renovations Scope

- Level drag fields
- Check and adjust all irrigation
- Deep tine aerate turf
- Over seed with Perianal Rye seed
- Broadcast granular nitrogen based fertilizer
- ► Apply 80/20 top soil with mechanical dresser


# Tree trim updates
