

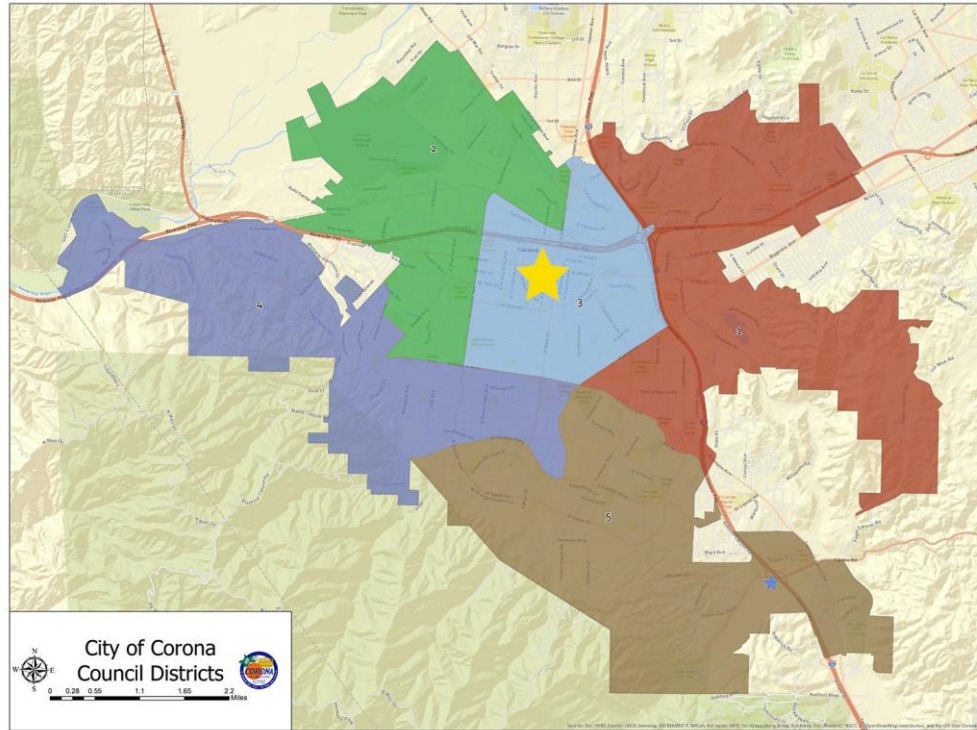

- One Point of Service
- Population: 168,000
- 40 square miles

# Activity at 650 S Main

---

- 368,000 visits annually
- Open 52 hours per week
- 389,000 items circulated annually
- 41,800 program attendees
- 9,436 passport applications processed
