SUBJECT:

City Council consideration of Resolution No. 2019-073 levying special taxes to be collected during Fiscal Year 2019-20 for the payment of the annual cost of the operation, maintenance and lighting of parkways, streets, roads, and open space within Community Facilities District No. 2011-1.

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

That the City Council adopt Resolution No. 2019-073 levying special taxes to be collected during Fiscal Year 2019-20 for the payment of the annual cost of the operation, maintenance and lighting of parkways, streets, roads, and open space within Community Facilities District No. 2011-1.

ANALYSIS:

It is necessary that the City Council levy special taxes for the payment of annual costs associated with the operation, maintenance and lighting of parkways, streets, roads, and open space, including street trees and landscape areas, street lights, traffic signals, and storm drain facilities within Community Facilities District No. 2011-1 (the "District"), pursuant to Section 53340 of the Government Code. Special taxes within the District are levied in an amount necessary to satisfy the Operation and Maintenance Special Tax Requirement, as defined in the District's Rate and Method of Apportionment (RMA). Any necessary replenishment or expenditure of the reserve funds and an amount estimated for administrative expenses during the year are included in the levy. The special taxes levied will not exceed the authorized amounts as provided in the RMA.

COMMITTEE ACTION:

Not applicable.

STRATEGIC PLAN:

This item supports the City's Strategic Plan Goal 6: Improve Communications with Our Community; Objective a: Commit to transparency in all City actions. The recommended action will help achieve these goals by providing concise, forthright information regarding the annual special taxes that will be

levied on each subject parcel within the District.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The following is a summary of the FY 2018-19 budgeted revenues and expenditures for the District:

The estimated operating excess will be accumulated in the reserve account to pay for future capital replacement projects. Pursuant to the Mello-Roos Community Facilities Act of 1982 (the "Act"), an adequate amount is retained in the reserve account to maintain the financial stability of the District.

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:

This action is exempt pursuant to Section 15061(b)(3) of the Guidelines for the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), which states that a project is exempt from CEQA if the activity is covered by the general rule that CEQA applies only to projects that have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. Where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment, the action is not subject to CEQA. This action merely sets the special taxes to be levied and collected within the District for Fiscal Year 2019-20, and there is no possibility that adopting the resolution will have a significant effect on the environment.

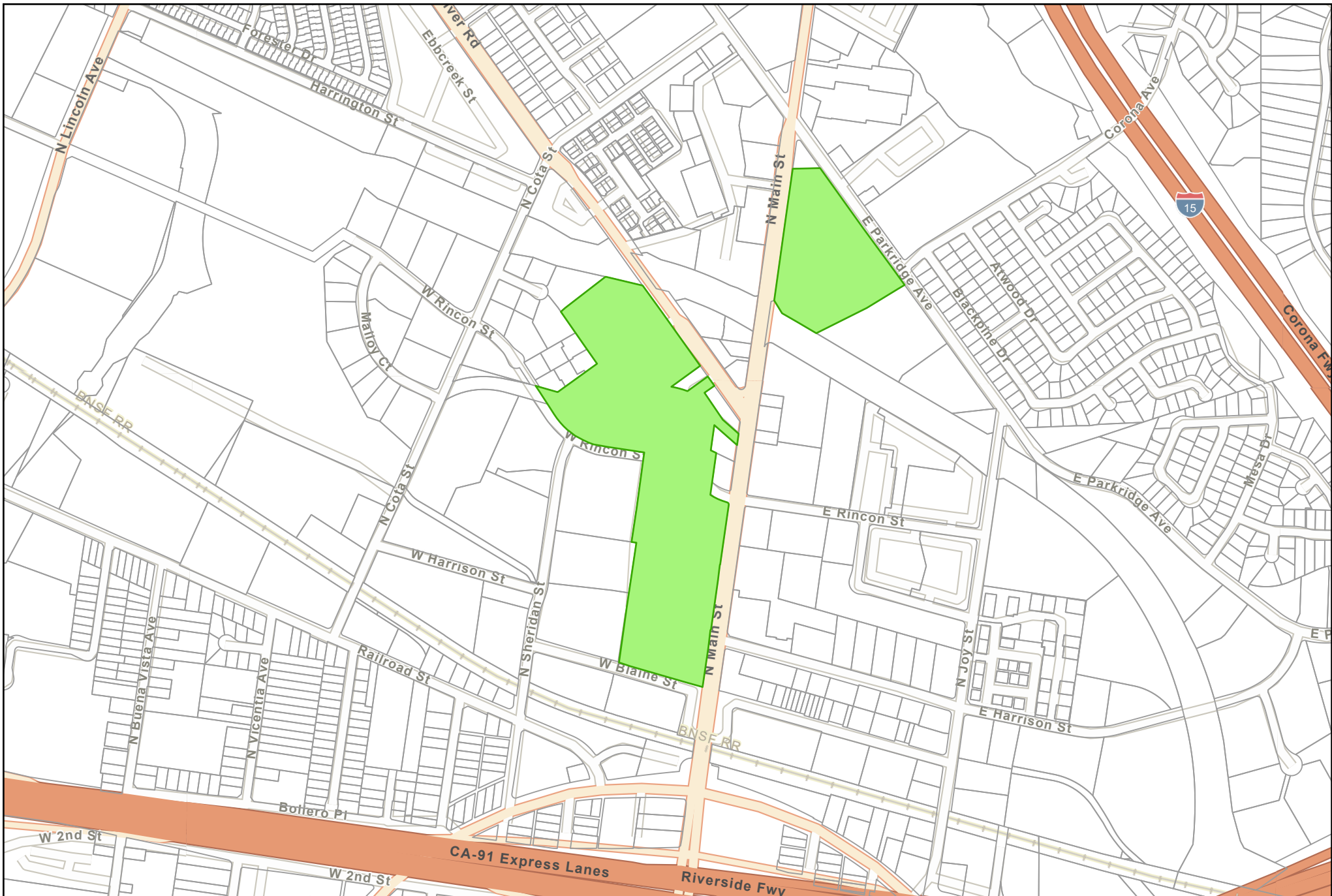

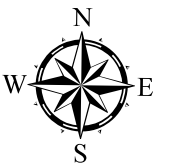

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-073

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
CORONA, CALIFORNIA, LEVYING SPECIAL TAXES TO
BE COLLECTED DURING FISCAL YEAR 2019-20 FOR
THE PAYMENT OF ANNUAL COST OF THE OPERATION,
MAINTENANCE AND LIGHTING OF PARKWAYS,
STREETS, ROADS, AND OPEN SPACE WITHIN
COMMUNITY FACILITIES DISTRICT NO. 2011-1**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Corona (“City Council”) previously established Community Facilities District No. 2011-1 of the City of Corona, County of Riverside, State of California (the “District”) pursuant to the terms and provisions of the Mello-Roos Community Facilities Act of 1982, as amended, commencing with Government Code Section 53311 (“Act”) to levy special taxes for the payment of annual cost of the operation, maintenance and lighting of parkways, streets, roads, and open space within the District and the surrounding area, and for the payment of administrative expenses incurred in connection with the levy and collection of said special taxes; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 53340 of the Government Code, the City Council may by resolution provide for the levy of special taxes on parcels of taxable property in the District at a rate provided by ordinance or at a lower rate; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has previously levied special taxes on parcels of taxable property in the District by resolution, including Resolution No. 2018-076 adopted on July 18, 2018 that levied special taxes on such parcels for Fiscal Year 2018-19 Fiscal Year; and

WHEREAS, all parcels of property in the District have been developed and the special taxes will be levied for Fiscal Year 2019-20 on all parcels in each category of developed property in the District on the same basis and at the same rate to pay annual cost of the operation and maintenance of parkways and open space within the District; and

WHEREAS, the rates of the special taxes that will be levied on such parcels for Fiscal Year 2019-20 will not exceed the rates previously approved by the qualified electors of the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Corona, California, as follows:

SECTION 1. Levy of Special Taxes. Special taxes shall be and are hereby levied for the Fiscal Year 2019-20 on all parcels of real property within the District which are subject to taxation, which are identified in Exhibit “A” attached hereto, and in the amount set forth for each such parcel in said Exhibit “A”. Pursuant to said Sections 53340 and 53358, such special taxes shall be collected in the same manner as ordinary ad valorem property taxes are

collected and shall be subject to the same penalties and the same procedure, sale, and lien priority in case of delinquency as is provided for ad valorem taxes.

SECTION 2. Transmittal to County. The City Clerk shall immediately following adoption of this resolution transmit a copy hereof to the Board of Supervisors and the County Auditor of the County of Riverside together with a request that the special taxes as levied hereby be collected on the tax bills for the parcels identified in Exhibit “A” hereto, along with the ordinary ad valorem property taxes to be levied on and collected from the owners of said parcels.
