
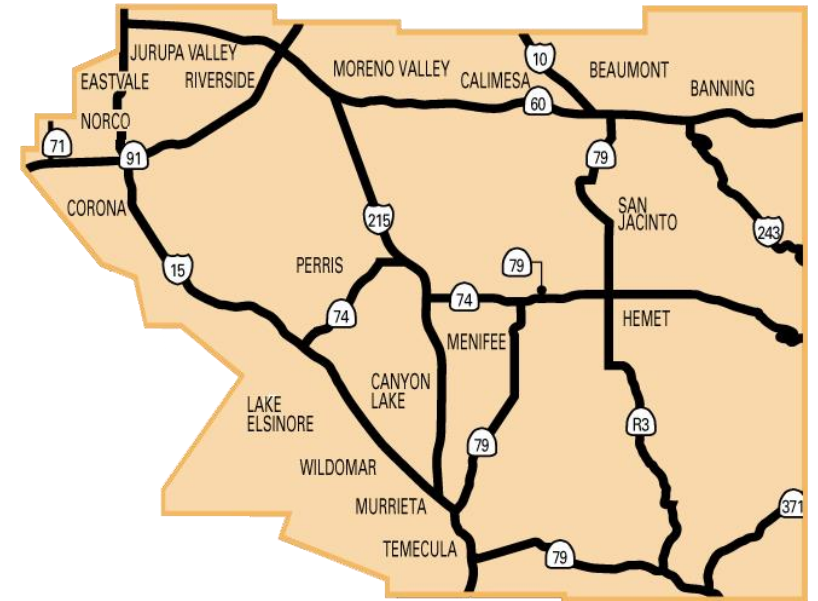


Riverside Transit Agency Service Change Updates Fiscal Year 2020

Riverside Transit Agency

- Established as a Joint Powers Agency on August 15, 1975
 - Service began on March 16, 1977
 - Service area: 2,500 square miles of western Riverside County
 - 18 cities and Supervisorial Districts I, II, III and V
- 



RTA Planned Service Changes

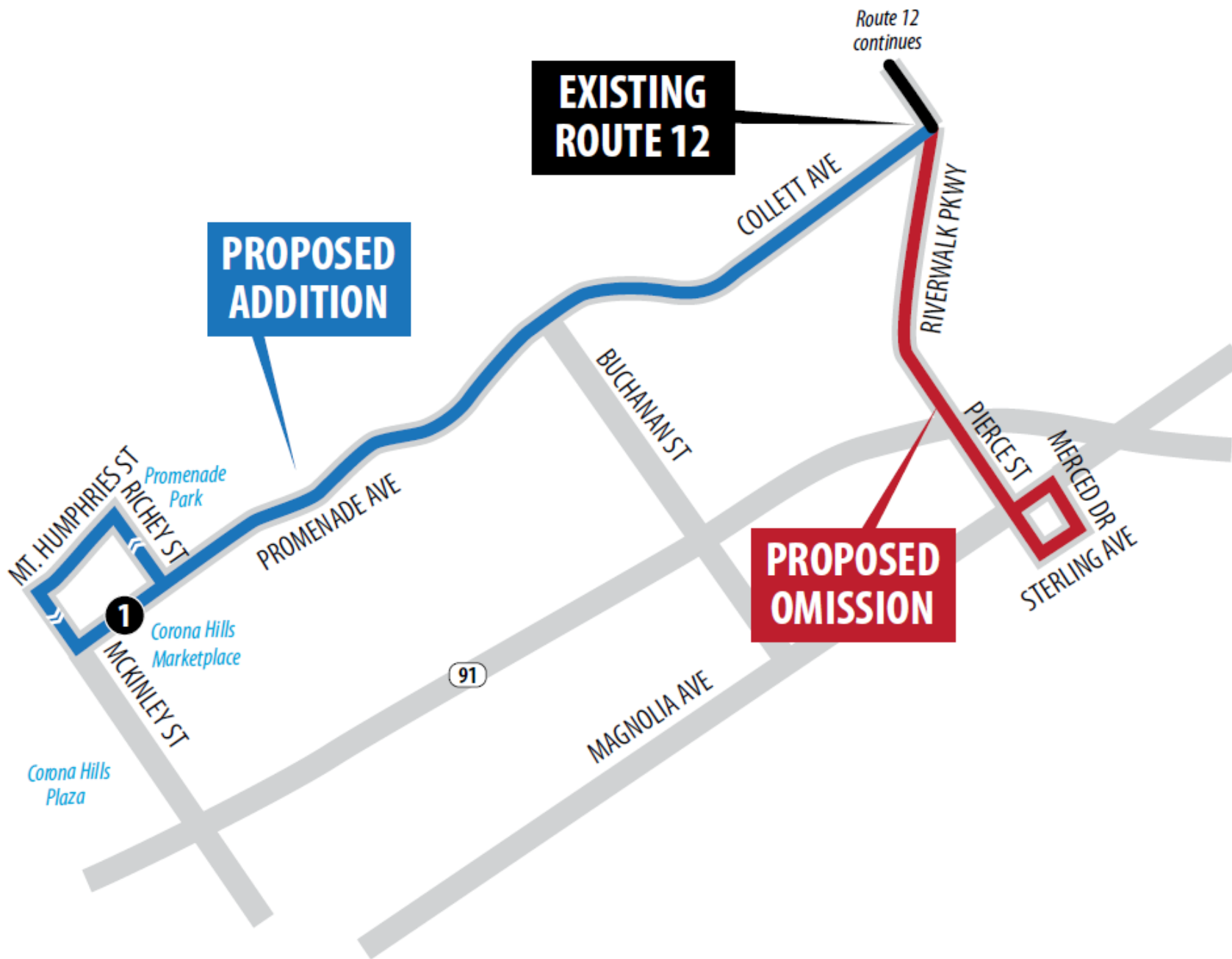
Three Planned Service Improvements:

- Route 12 Extension: Corona Hills Plaza
- New Route 4: Eastvale – Norco - Corona
- Route 1 weekend service: UCR – Downtown Riverside – Corona

Route 12 Extension

- **Route extension from Riverside to Corona Hills Plaza**
 - Connects Riverside residents to Corona Hills Plaza
 - Connects Corona residents to RCC and Downtown Riverside
 - Good transit access during McKinley grade separation project
 - Planned implementation September 8, 2019, no civil work





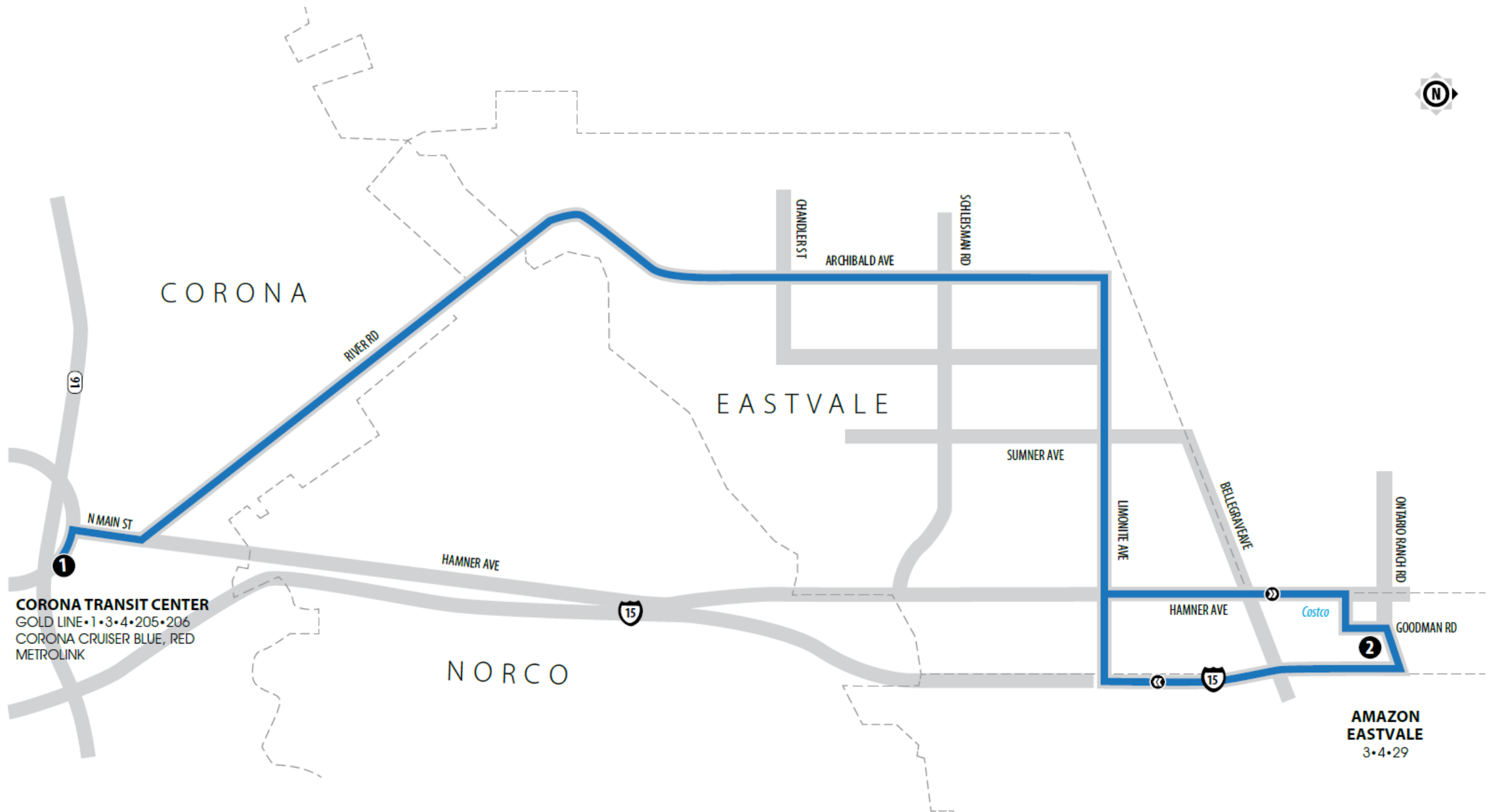
Route 12: Proposed Bus Stops



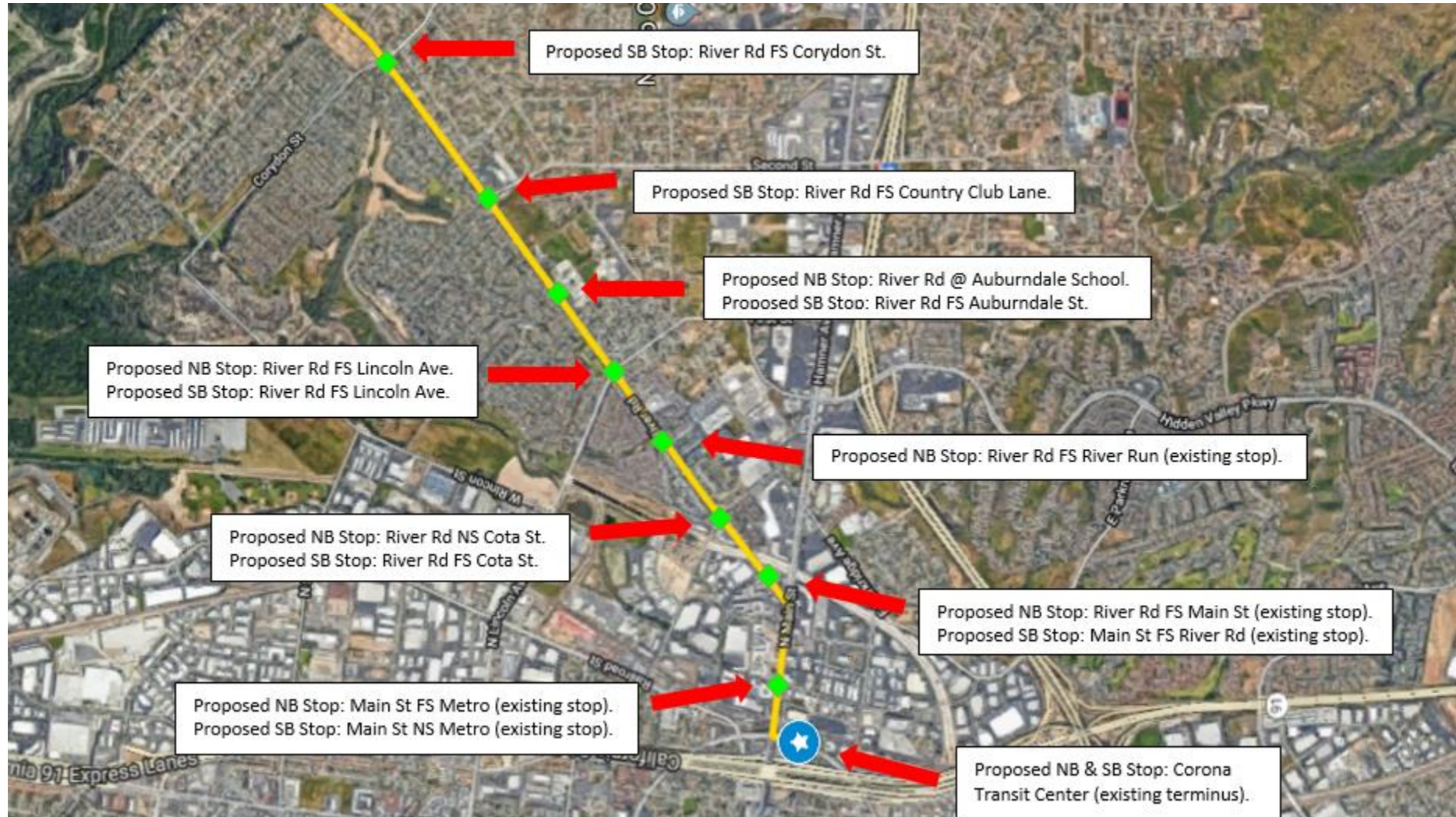
New Route 4

- **New Route 4 Eastvale–Norco–Corona via Archibald Ave/River Rd**
 - Fast service to Corona Transit Center, connections to RTA and Metrolink
 - New stops in City of Corona: River Rd at Main St, Cota St, Lincoln Ave, Auburndale St, Country Club Ln and Corydon St
 - Planned implementation January 2020, subject to approval and completion of required bus stop civil work



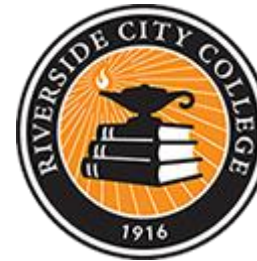


Route 4: Proposed Bus Stops



Route 1

- **Corona Transit Center – Downtown Riverside – UCR**
 - Busiest route on the network, 5,972 average daily ridership on weekdays, 6,218 average daily ridership on weekends
 - Improving frequency to 15 minute service on Saturday and Sunday from 10:00am-5:00pm
 - Planned implementation September 2019
