Objectives:

- Attend community organization meetings and report back to the Commission
- Create a regular agenda item for the Commission to assign event attendance and delegate tasks

Goal 2: Build relationships and enhance partnerships with volunteers, community organizations and businesses

Objectives:

- Hold two board membership positions with the Corona Parks Foundation
- Present the Park Ambassador Program and how to use SeeClickFix for parks at community meetings and sporting events, such as season opening days
- Recognize and award residents who volunteer for Parks and Recreation programs
- Designate calendar days where the Commissioners and community join together to beautify parks

- Have presentations on deferred maintenance items at the parks and facilities
- Have yearly presentation on the budget as it pertains to development impact fees, park and park facility maintenance and capital projects
