


About Harbor Recuperative Care Center

Harbor Recuperative Care (HRC) is located in Mission Hills, CA. The HRC offers 30 beds of shelter for injured or ill homeless individuals nearing release from hospitals.

The HRC provides Intensive Case Management and Housing Location services for its residents. The HRC also provides three (3) meals a day, seven (7) days a week for homeless residents through partnership with our commercial catering kitchen. HRC residents are connected to mental health and medical services through clinic partner, San Fernando Community Health Center, a Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC).

The aim of the HRC is to assist recently discharged individuals in their recovery by providing shelter, housing-focused case management, and dietary health.



Headquartered in Mission Hills, CA, Harbor Recuperative Care Center provides that "home" environment where residents are monitored by medical staff in an onsite clinic while receiving case management from social workers.



The goal of the HRC is to aid in the recovery of individuals who have been recently discharged from the hospital by providing shelter, housing-focused case management, and nourishing food and then to transition each resident from Recuperative Care to more permanent Housing.

Services Provided to Our Residents:

WEEKLY RESIDENT ASSESSMENT

The assessment is the gathering of information about a patient's physiological, psychological, sociological, and spiritual status by trained staff. The assessment is the first step in the resident's process.

INTENSIVE CASE MANAGEMENT

Case management services are provided by healthcare professionals working with people to identify issues and barriers that may prevent them from getting better and uncovering mutually agreed upon solutions to achieve their healthcare goals.

DAILY VITALS

The four main vital signs routinely monitored by health care providers: Body temperature, Pulse rate, Respiration rate, and Blood pressure

TRANSPORTATION TO/FROM APPOINTMENTS

- · Get to regular doctor appointments
- · Get to dental appointments and eye exams
- · Go to the DMV

- · Pick up prescriptions
