- → GSAs are required to adopt a Groundwater Sustainability Plan (GSP) and submit to the Department of Water Resources (DWR)



What is a GSP?

- A groundwater sustainability plan developed and managed by a GSA
- → Specifies measures to address groundwater issues and ensure the basin is operated equitably
- → The purpose is to achieve defined sustainability goal
- Emphasis on stakeholder engagement
