back up pump at each manhole.

2.03 Question: "What is the redundancy required for the bypass?"

Response: Contractor must have primary and a secondary bypass pump for

each gravity main flowing into the lift station.

2.04 Question: "What is the Force Main Pressure?"

Response: The force main pressure is 45 psi.

### TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

#### PROJECT DESCRIPTION Α.

Rehabilitation of 8' diameter x 33' deep sewer lift station interior wall with 125 mils of two part polyurethane epoxy to meet the standards set forth in the Standard Specifications for Public Works Construction (SSPWC – Greenbook 2018 edition and errata) Specification 502-5.3 – Manhole and Structure Rehabilitation - Polyurethane and Epoxy Lining System.

#### В. TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

- 11. Surface preparation including removal of any existing coatings or linings.
- 12. Water for Contractor's activities.
- 13. Traffic Control
- 14. Equipment Storage during construction activities.
- 15. BMP's for NPDES or SWPPP.
- 16. All permits and licenses.
- 17. City Staff shall turn on and off all valves in the vicinity with a minimum of 24 hour notice.
- 18. Contractor shall be responsible for dewatering activities.
- 19. Vactor services, as needed, during life of the Project.


