**SUBJECT: Notice Inviting Bids No. 22-012CA**

**Addendum No. 1  
Corrosion and Scale Inhibitor Potable Water Treatment Chemical**

This Addendum No. 1 to the subject Notice Inviting Bids provides answers to questions received. Please note the bid due date and time have not changed.

All provisions of this Addendum No. 1 are hereby incorporated by reference into the subject NIB. Bidders shall account for all provisions pursuant to this Addendum No. 1 in submitting their bids. Each bidder shall acknowledge receipt of this Addendum in their Bid in the spaces provided therein.

**1. Questions & Answers:**

1.1 Question: “Can you please clarify how the delivery process for the totes are completed? The Technical Specification/Scope of Work section states a minimum of 2 totes per delivery but the Delivery Section discusses bulk quantities, certified weight tickets and chocking of vehicles?”

Response: Currently all corrosion and scale inhibitor deliveries are via totes. Chocking of delivery vehicles is required.

1.2 Question: “What are you currently paying?”

Response: \$8.57/gallon

1.3 Question: “Who is the current supplier?”

Response: Brenntag Pacific

1.4 Question: “What's the difference between "line items" and "cost file" under Bid Information tab?”

- Response: The cost file requirement has been eliminated. Bidders are required to enter their pricing on the Line Items Tab in PlanetBids and complete, sign and upload the Bid / Price Form.
- 1.5 Question: “Please provide the current suppliers and their price.”
- Response: Brenntag Pacific, \$8.57/gallon
- 1.6 Question: “Can you provide the last bid tabulation?”
- Response: Bid tabulation is no longer available. Please refer to question 1.5 for current supplier and pricing information.
- 1.7 Question: “The bid document states that the bidder is required to submit manufacturer’s information including an affidavit of compliance to the appropriate AWWA Standard and ANSI/NSF standard, a COA, manufacturer’s name and address, Product Bulletin and Typical Properties, and Safety Data Sheet. However there is not a section in the electronic bid to submit this information. How would you like this information submitted?”
- Response: Please include with your completed Price Form.
- 1.8 Question: “Why is a new bid being issued, one was issued in June?”
- Response: This chemical (ortho polyphosphate) was inadvertently left off the last chemical bid. The City’s intent is to have all chemicals on the same bid schedule.
