

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-116

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORONA, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF APPLICATIONS WITH THE FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION, AN OPERATING ADMINISTRATION OF THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, FOR FEDERAL TRANSPORTATION ASSISTANCE AUTHORIZED BY 49 U.S.C. CHAPTER 53, TITLE 23, UNITED STATES CODE, OR OTHER FEDERAL STATUTES ADMINISTERED BY THE FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION

WHEREAS, the Federal Transportation Administrator has been delegated authority to award federal financial assistance for transportation projects; and

WHEREAS, grants or cooperative agreements for federal financial assistance will impose certain obligations upon the applicant, and may require the applicant to provide the local share of the project cost; and

WHEREAS, the applicant has or will provide all annual certifications and assurances to the Federal Transportation Administration required for the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Corona, California, as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or designee authorized by the City Manager are authorized to execute and file applications for federal assistance on behalf of the City of Corona with the Federal Transit Administration for federal assistance authorized by 49 U.S.C. Chapter 53, Title 23, United States Code, or other Federal statutes authorizing projects administered by the Federal Transit Administration. Southern California Association of Governments is the Designated Recipient as defined by 49 U.S.C Section 5307(a)(2). Through a Supplemental Agreement between Federal Transit Administration, Southern California Association of Governments, and the City of Corona, Southern California Association of Governments assigns rights to the City of Corona to receive and dispense Federal funds for the Urbanized Area Formula Program.

SECTION 2. The City Manager, or designee authorized by the City Manager and the City Attorney are authorized to execute and file with its applications the annual certifications and assurances and other documents the Federal Transportation Administration requires before awarding a Federal assistance grant of cooperative agreement.

SECTION 3. The City Manager, or designee authorized by the City Manager are

authorized to execute grant and cooperative agreements with the Federal Transit Administration on behalf of the City of Corona.

SECTION 4. The City Manager or designee authorized by the City Manager are authorized to approve payment requests submitted to the Federal Transit Administration on behalf of the City of Corona.

SECTION 5. Repeal of Resolution No. 2020-088. Resolution No. 2020-088 is hereby repealed and of no further force or effect.
