WHEREAS, the County of Riverside ("COUNTY") and SC Commercial, LLC ("CONTRACTOR") entered into that Service Agreement for Fuel Delivery Services, effective October 1, 2011 (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR now desire to amend the Agreement for the seventh time to revise the period of performance.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration the receipt and adequacy of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.
2. The Period of Performance of the Agreement is hereby extended until March 31, 2022.
3. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement not modified herein shall remain unchanged.
4. This Amendment No. 7 shall be effective 10/1/2021
5. This Amendment No. 7 may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which will be an original, but all of which together will constitute one instrument. Each party to this Amendment No. 7 agrees to the use of electronic signatures, such as digital signatures that meet the requirements of the California Uniform Electronic Transactions Act ("CUETA") Cal. Civ. Code §§ 1633.1 to 1633.17), for executing this Amendment No. 7. The parties further agree that the electronic signatures of the parties included in this Amendment No. 7 are intended to authenticate this writing and to have the same force and effect as manual signatures. Electronic signature means an electronic sound, symbol, or process attached to or logically associated with an electronic record and executed or adopted by a person with the intent to sign the electronic record pursuant to the CUETA as amended from time to time. The CUETA authorizes use of an electronic signature for transactions and contracts among parties in California, including a government agency. Digital signature means an electronic identifier, created by computer, intended by the party using it to have the same force and effect as the use of a manual signature, and shall be reasonably relied upon by the parties. For purposes of this section, a digital signature is a type of "electronic signature" as defined in subdivision (i) of Section 1633.2 of the Civil Code.






