Action: Information and Discussion

Ms. Cynthia Lara, Administrative Services Manager, introduced item to the committee for a potential tenant at the Historic Civic Center (HCC). The Stephen Center is requesting to lease the last available space at the HCC. Ms. Lara noted that the HCC is will be fully occupied with all non-profit tenants.
