BACKGROUND

The Military Banner program was created to recognize and celebrate Corona residents or their immediate family members (spouse, parents, children, or siblings) who are currently serving on active duty in the United States Armed Forces (Air Force, Army, Coast Guard, Marines, Navy, or National Guard).



CURRENT BANNER LOCATIONS

CURRENT BANNERS:

- 228 Active Service Members banners installed.
- 28 banner applications from Corona residents on the waitlist to be installed. As of May 2020.


Military Banner Zones:

- Main St. from SR-91 south to Mountain Gate Park.
- Sixth St. from the I-15 to Paseo Grande.
- 228 total number of poles designated for Military Banners.


How to Participate...

- Serviceperson must be serving on active duty. For the purpose of this program, active duty is defined as 12 months of continuous service in the United States Armed Forces.
- Serviceperson or immediate family member is a City of Corona resident, attended school in the Corona Norco Unified School District or works in Corona.
- Residency must be verified with a recent utility bill, driver's license, or other form of identification listing a current City of Corona address. Non-resident applicants will be responsible for cost of banner, including production of the banner, staff/ labor time and installation.
- Applications for the Military Banner program are accepted on a first come, first serve basis. **Banner location is selected at random.**
- → Applicant will be notified once banner has been installed.
- → Banners will be installed 4 times per year.
- Can expand as needed to reduce/ eliminate waitlists.
